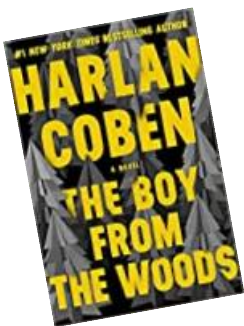

The LAW membership will vote by Yea or Nay vote for this Slate of Officers at the June LAW Luncheon. Thank you

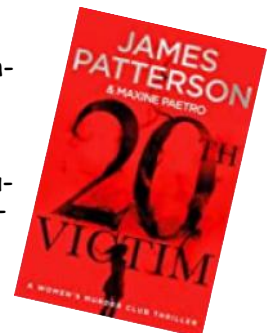
